## Parent Information September 20th 2021

### Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will commence at **8.10am**.

Children and parents should enter the school via the turning circle entrance. Gates will open at 8.10am and children should not arrive any earlier than this. Admission to Breakfast Club closes at 8.30am – children must be registered by then.

All children attending Breakfast Club should be walked to the main reception for registration. Key Stage 2 pupils may be dropped off and allowed to walk in alone. Foundation phase parents should park offsite and walk children in and follow the one way system through the school. **Cars cannot be left on the turning circle. Parents should not enter the school building.**

### School and Nursery – Drop Off and Pick Up

**School and Nursery will revert to pre pandemic start and finish times from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

**School gates will be opened at 8.50am – class doors will open at this time and children should arrive to start school for a prompt 9am start.**

Children and Parents should not arrive at school before 8.50am. Supervision of pupils starts at this time. Children remain the responsibility of parents until this time.

In order to manage such a volume of children and parents on site for a 9am start we have consulted with NCC Health and Safety section and governors have approved the following arrangements:

There will be **no parent parking on site at either the start or end of the school and nursery days**. Key Stage 2 children may be dropped off at the turning circle and can walk to their classes through the one way system. Key Stage 2 children cannot drop off younger siblings. There will be very limited staff supervision at this time as staff will all be in class.

All Foundation Phase children (Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2) must be walked to school by an adult



and dropped **at the classroom doors.**

One way systems through the school grounds will remain in place for collection and dropping off.

### **One Way System 1 – Front of the School**

One way systems at the front of the school will start at the gate by the turning circle and continue through to the exit gate at the junior end of the school

### **One Way System 2 – Back of the School**

2) One way system at the back of the school will start at the gate onto the infant yard and continue through to the exit gate onto Cwm Cwddy Drive (rear of the school).

### **Dropping Off 8.50am – 9.00am**

Parents dropping off for the following classes should use the one way system 1:-

- 5JW
- 4TG
- 3JB
- 3RD
- 2LN
- 2JB



## Morning Nursery

Parents dropping off for the following classes should use the one way system 2:-

6RC  
5TM  
4EJ  
1SB  
1AD  
Reception -RLE  
Reception - RLS

Parents dropping off pupils from both sides of the school (front and rear) should use one way system 1 first go out of the junior side gate along the outside of the school fence then back through one way system 2 second.

Parents and childminders who are dropping off children in Nursery , year 2, year 3, 4TG, 5JW or 6GS and have siblings in 6RC, 5TM and 4EJ can follow the one way system around to their classroom doors.

### **Collection 3.15pm & 3.30pm**

Children in Foundation Phase (2LN, 2JB, 1AD, 1SB, Reception and Afternoon Nursery) will finish school and require collecting at **3.15pm**.

Children is KS2 (6GS, 6RC, 5JW, 5TM, 4TG, 4EJ, 3JB & 3RD) will finish school and require collecting at **3.30pm**.

Afternoon Nursery

Parents **collecting** pupils from the following classes should use one way system 2:-

Parents and childminders collecting pupils from Foundation Phase (3.15pm) and KS2 (3.30pm) should collect Foundation Phase pupils first at 3.15pm and then KS2 pupils at 3.30pm.



A reminder to parents of Key Stage 2 children that if you want them to walk home unaccompanied then you must e mail school to give permission.

I am introducing these changes from Monday and will monitor, evaluate and review them as the weeks go on.

This will not be perfect for everybody. However we believe that this will be the safest situation to manage the increased volume of children and parents on school site at the same time, particularly when we are seeing a rise in positive cases.

Can I thank you in advance for your cooperation with these changes and in particular:

- Following our one way system to keep all safe
- The wearing of face coverings for all adults on school site
- Maintaining physical distancing from other adults and not congregating in large groups at the school gates
- Not arriving too early or too late for school
- Being very considerate of our neighbours by parking sensibly, not blocking drives or pathways
